

■Please read all relevant instructions carefully before use.

- ■The notes marked here will help you to use the product safely and correctly.
- ■In order to clearly indicate the extent of potential harm and damage, precautions are divided into "Warning" and "Caution" that may be caused by incorrect use. Both of them are important for safety and must be followed.

Storage conditions



- ■Storage room temperature: 5 °C to 40 °C.
- ■Relative humidity (RH) between 20% and 80%; free of corrosive gases, and a well-ventilated room.

Product service and maintenance

- ■This product should be maintained by the service center designated by the manufacturer only. No user should disassemble or maintain it without permission.
- ■Do not forget to turn off the main power switch after usage.
- Do not use this product if the power socket becomes loose.
- ■If this product will be left unused for a long period of time, it is necessary to roll up the power cord of this product and store this product in a dry and dust-free environment.



Caution

- ■Do not store this product at a high temperature or near open flame. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunshine.
- ■Please clean this product with a dry cloth. Never use thinner, benzene or alcohol.
- ■The mechanical components of this product are specially designed and manufactured, so no special maintenance is needed.

Solutions to ordinary malfunctions

- If the motor sounds during operation of this product, this is the normal operation sound.

- ■If the rated working time is over, this product will automatically activate the power-off button; If this product keeps operating for a long period of time, the temperature protector will stop this product automatically. The product can be used again after half an hour.






Bracket Installation Instruction


- 1. After aligning the positioning pillar under the bracket with the positioning hole on the armrest support, buckle the bracket on the support (Figure 1).
- 2. Fix the bracket with three M4*10 cross recessed pan-head self-tapping locking screws with washer (Figure 2).






- 3. After the bracket is fixed, buckle the decorative cover of the support on it (Figure 3).
- 4. The bracket installation is finished (Figure 2).






Calf Installation Instruction


- After connecting the air pipes on the calf and the massage chair with the wire harness, unfasten the fixed pipeline strap and insert the connecting part into the seat frame (Figure 1). Note: After plugging in the air pipe and wire harness, it needs to cut off the wire tie fixing the wire harness.
- 2. Place the round tubes on the left and right sides of the calf on the calf support (Figure 2).






Part Installation

- 3. Turn over the calf fixing cover to cover the round tubes on both sides of the calf (Figure 3).
- 4. Fasten the calf to the massage chair with two M5 screws (respectively on the left and right), and check whether there is any abnormality in the up and down movement, and the pipeline is overfolded, and then the calf installation is finished (Figure 4).






Massage Chair Placement

Installation placement

Make sure there is enough space for the massage chair to be able to tilt at least 5 cm.

Do not expose the massage chair directly to high temperature environment due to sunlight(such as: in front of heating equipment), and place it to where can avoid high temperature and direct sunlight. It is recommended to lay a soft, protective mat underneath the chair for long-term use in a designated location. When laying the mat, the size of the mat should be enough to cover the complete underside of the chair. Keep the range where the machine touches the floor and the range where your feet touch the floor.




Product lift instruction

A team lift is required to move the chair and avoid injury.

- Please lift the massage chair to move it on hard surfaced floors to avoid damage to the floor.
- 2.To avoid damage to any type of floor as well as the chair's casters, it is recommended the chair be lifted when moved and not slid or pushed. When the chair is lifted and moved to the designated position, be careful to keep your hands and feet out of the way to avoid injury. Do not let go of the unit until the unit is completely flat and level on the ground. To prevent damage to the floor, it is recommended to place a mat or protective barrier between the unit and the floor.




Move method

Use the rear casters to move the massage chair. Move the chair by tilting it down and backward about 45° as shown in the diagram.



NOTE: Excessive force to title will cause the chair to tip over completely and product damage.

- 1.Before moving, please shut down the machine properly to reset the whole machine, and then cut off the power.
- 2.Please keep the chair vacant when moving. (People, pets or clutter will not be able to stay on the chair.)
- 3. When moving, do not cross a drop barrier higher than 2mm or a gap greater than 5mm.
- 4. When using casters to move this product, single continuous movement is not supported; if the distance exceeds 50 meters, please make this product move slowly and evenly.



How to disassemble and use headrest cushion and backrest cushion

Using a headrest cushion can reduce the intensity of kneading massage on the neck and shoulders, and you can decide whether to use a headrest cushion according to your needs (recommended to use a headrest cushion). The backrest cushion and the backrest are connected by a zipper (1), and the headrest pad and the backrest pad are connected by a Velcro (2).

Check around Make sure that there are no people, pets and other objects around the unit. Caution

Make sure there are no foreign objects in the gaps of the machine

Before massaging, make sure that no foreign objects are caught in the legs, feet. etc.

Under no circumstances allow hands, feet, and head to penetrate into the area between the lower leg mechanism and main body, or the area between the armrest and the capsule.


Schematic diagram of power on







Product structure

- 1. Display screen:
- ·TFT color LCD (liquid crystal display), which can display the massage function in running state.
- 2. Standby key:
- ·Turn on or off the massage chair.
- 3.Up key:
- ·Navigation up key, select a function upward in the menu, or adjust the massage position upward.
- 4. Left key:
- ·Navigation left key, select a function leftward or enter the left menu.
- 5. OK key:
- ·Confirm the massage function selected.
- 6. Menu key:
- Enter the main menu selection interface. For detailed function information, please see Pages 13-26 hereof.
- 7. Automatic key:
- Enter the automatic function mode selection interface. For detailed function information, please see Pages 13-14 hereof.
- 8.Interconnected sit-up key:
- According to the required massage angle, simultaneously adjust the backrest support and the calf support to the most comfortable interconnected sit-up massage position.
- 9. Calf support lowering key:
- Lower the calf support to the most comfortable massage position according to user's personalized massage needs.
- 10.Pause key:
- Pause all currently running massage functions, press this key again to resume all massage functions before the pause.
- 11.Right key:
- ·Navigation right key, select a function rightward or enter the menu on the right.
- 12. Down key:
- ·Navigation Down key, select a function downward in the menu, or adjust the massage position downward.
- 13. Back key:
- Return to the function information interface in the current running state, or return to the previous interface.
- 14. Automatic lying key:
- Each time press the key, it can switch to an automatic lying angle that simulates zero gravity. There are three angles in total, which can be switched over cyclically.
- 15.Interconnected lying key:
- According to the required massage angle, simultaneously adjust the backrest support and the calf support for the interconnected lying to the most comfortable interconnected lying massage position.
- 16. Calf support up key:
- Adjust the calf support to the most comfortable massage position to satisfy the user's personalized massage needs.


- 1. 4D strength knob key: Adjust the massage strength of the 4D manipulator.
- 2. Standby key: Turn on or off the massage chair.
- Automatic lying key: Adjust the lying angle of the massage chair's simulative zero gravity.
- 4. Adjust the stretching of the calf support: Adjust the stretching of the small foot stand.
- 5. Adjust the shortening of the calf support: Adjust the shortening of the small foot stand.
- 6. Wireless charging position: Wireless charging for mobile phone.
- 7. Heating key: Turn on or off the heating function.
- Voice control awake key: Short press the key to wake up the voice control function, long press it for 3 seconds to turn on and off the voice function.


- 9. Interconnected lying key: Adjust the angle of interconnected lying.
- 10. Interconnected sit-up key: Adjust the angle of interconnected sit-up.

Operation Instructions

- I.Massage function control operation
- 1.Standby
- (1). After the massage chair is powered on and off, it can be turned on by pressing the power key in the standby state (the LED light is off) or by intelligent voice control (the LED light is on), and the backrest support and calf support can be adjusted and woken up by voice control. The rest of the functions cannot be used.
- 2.Start massage (standby key)
- 1).Press the standby key to start the massage chair and enter the preferred user option. There are two options respectively for men and women. The strength for men is strong, and for women is gentle.
- 2).Enter the automatic program screen, select any one of automatic programs, and lie down on the backrest. The calf support slightly lifts up and the unit will start to automatically detect the full body shape and shoulder position. User can also use the knob on the shortcut keys to rotate and adjust, select the corresponding programs up and down, and then press the standby key for confirmation.



- (1). Shoulder position and body shape detection
- 1). After selecting a mode for men or women, the position of the backrest support and the calf support will be adjusted to the set angle.
- 2). After adjusting the angle, the massage chair will automatically detect the body shape and shoulder position (Note: If users want to skip the function for shoulder position and body shape detection, press "OK" to cancel this function and start the massage).



(2). Shoulder position adjustment

- 1). After detecting the shoulder position, the buzzer will buzz. If it fails to fit the actual shoulder position, press "Up" or "Down" to adjust it to an appropriate position. There is a total of 11 levels for adjusting the shoulder position. If there is no shoulder position adjustment within 10 seconds, it will automatically enter the massage function. If users directly press "OK" to enter the massage function immediately, and if the shoulder position is not detected, it will start massage according to the default shoulder position height.
- 2).Note: During the massage, press "Up" or "Down" to select the "Shoulder Position" key in the information interface, and then press "OK" key to enter the shoulder position subinterface, and then press the "Up" or "Down" to adjust the shoulder position.



Key	Description
	Adjust the position of the massage ball upwards to reach a suitable shoulder position.
(0)	Adjust the position of the massage ball downwards to reach a suitable shoulder position.

3). After entering the massage program, it shows the running state information interface. If users need to adjust the shoulder position, users can directly press the "Up Key" or "Down Key" to select the "Shoulder Position", and then press "OK" to enter the shoulder position sub-interface, then press "Up" or "Down" to adjust the height of the shoulder position. Press "Back" to return to the previous menu, or wait 10 seconds to automatically return to the information interface.



(3).Adjustment

- 1). After entering the massage program, if users need to adjust the massage position, press "Menu" on the hand controller to enter the main menu interface, and press "Up" or "Down" or "Left" or "Right" to select an adjustment icon, press "OK" to enter the adjustment function interface, and then press "Left" or "Right" to select the massage function that needs to be adjusted.
- 2).Under the running state information interface, users can also directly press "Up" or "Down" to select the adjustment key and press "OK" to enter the adjustment interface to select the massage function that needs to be adjusted.
- 3). Under the massage parts interface, if the massage area is fixed or partial, users can directly press "Up" or "Down" to adjust the manipulator up and down.
- 4). Under the manual program interface, if the massage position is not fixed or partial, users need to adjust the massage position to such state, and then press "Back" to select the adjustment function to enter the massage position interface, and then press "Up" or "Down" to move the manipulator up and down.




3. Pause Key

When the massage function is running, press "Pause" to temporarily stop all massage functions; press "Pause" again to resume the massage function. If the pause time exceeds 20 minutes, all massage functions will be automatically turned off.




4.Menu Key (main menu)

- (1).Press "Menu" to enter the main menu massage function selection interface, including automatic program, smart lift, personalized program, manual program, adjustment, settings and other function interfaces.
- (2).Press "Up" or "Down" or "Left" or "Right" to select the massage function, and press "OK" to enter the massage function selected. Press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.



- 5.Automatic Program (Main Menu-Automatic Program, users can also directly press "Automatic" to enter the automatic program interface)
- (1).Press "Menu" to enter the main menu interface, press "Up" or "Down" or "Left" or "Right" to select the automatic program; the automatic program includes a total of seven kinds of automatic massage functions: 4D escort, leisure and health care, shoulder and neck care, Thai-style stretching, sedentariness stretching, relaxation, refreshing.
- (2).Press "Up" or "Down" to select the automatic massage function, and press "OK" to enter the automatic massage function selected. Press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.



Function	Description	
4D massage	It adopts a variety of massage techniques designed for fatigued neck and shoulders, waist and hips. The strength level is moderate to relieve fatigue.	
Relax massage	It is mainly for relaxation, and it adopts massage techniques such as tuina and kneading for full body massage, focusing on the waist and buttocks to help relax the body and mind.	
Shoulders care	It adopts a variety of massage techniques such as kneading, tuina, and lifting to massage the neck and shoulders to help relieve fatigue.	
Thai stretch	Inspired by Thai-style massage, it adopts 4D movement which is fitted with powerful airbags to stretch the body, massage the waist, so as to help relieve muscle fatigue and reinforce body vitality.	
Sedentary stretch	It adopts a variety of massage techniques such as pushing up, kneading and patting to intensively massage the waist and buttocks to help relax the tense muscles, stretch body and mind.	
Sports healing	It is a massage program designed for exercisers for exercise recovery, and it adopts massage techniques such as kneading and patting to massage the whole body, so as to help relieve muscle soreness after exercise and accelerate muscle recovery.	
Elderly massage	It is a massage program designed for the elderly and the under-stressed group, and it mainly adopts massage techniques such as gentle kneading and pressing throughout the whole process, assisted by medium-speed swinging movements and suitable for leisure time after tea and meals.	

Note: The automatic function that has been selected and used will be displayed in the massage function state bar, and users can directly press "Back" to view the running state.

6.Smart Lift (Main Menu-Smart Lift)

- (1).Press "Menu" to enter the main menu interface, press "Up" or "Down" or "Left" or "Right" to select the Smart Lift function which includes a total of three massage modes.
- (2).Press "Up" or "Down" to select the desired automatic massage function, and press "OK" to enter the massage function selected. Press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.



Function	Description	
Vitality Activation	This program is suitable for 7 a.m9 a.m., and it adopts a variety of massage techniques to massage the neck, assisted by other massage programs, so a to wake up the sleeping body and start a nice day.	
Lunch Break	This program is suitable for 12 p.m3 p.m., and it adopts a variety of massage techniques to massage the waist and back, assisted by proper neck kneading, so as to help users relieve fatigue during halftime.	
Sleep Aid	This program is suitable for relaxing before going to bed at night, and it adopts massage techniques with gentle, mild, moderate and slow speed to massage the whole body, assisted by the swinging motion of the massage chair, soften and relax the body, so as to help sleep at night.	

7.Personalized Program (main menu-personalized)

- (1).Press "Menu" to enter the main menu interface, press "Up" or "Down" and "Left" or "Right" to select personalized programs which include a total of four personalized massage modes (i.e. neck and shoulder massage, back massage, waist and hip massage, and legs and feet massage).
- (2).Press "Up" or "Down" to select any personalized massage function, and press "OK" to enter the personalized massage function selected. Press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.



Function	Description	
Massage shoulder	This program adopts kneading and lifting massage techniques to intensively massage the acupoints on the neck and shoulders, helping relax the neck and shoulders.	
Massage the back	This program adopts Tuina and acupressure massage techniques to intensively massage the back, helping relax the back.	
Massage waist&buttocks	This program adopts kneading and Tuina massage techniques to intensively massage the waist and buttocks, helping to relieve muscle tension in the waist and buttocks.	
Massage legs & feet	This program adopts kneading and scraping massage techniques, assisted by some calf stretching movements, helping relax the calf muscles.	

8. Manual Program (main menu-manual program)

- (1).Press "Menu" to enter the main menu interface, press "Up" or "Down" or "Left" or "Right" to select manual program, and then press "OK" to enter the manual program interface.
- (2). Manual program includes massage technique, massage position, air pressure, and other massage functions.
- (3).After entering the manual program interface, press "Left" or "Right" to switch over between left and right submenu options, then press "Up" or "Down" to select the desired massage function option, and then press "OK" for confirmation; Press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.






Manual Mode Wise Area Air Spot Partial Full back Upper back Lower back Select with "Left&Right&Up&Down", and press" OK*





- 1). Manual Program (main menu-massage technique)
- · Manual massage techniques: There are a total of eleven manual massage techniques including Stop, Knead, Tap I, Tap II, Knead&Tap, Shiatsu I, Shiatsu II, Grab, 4D II, 4D III, and 4D IV.
- After entering the massage technique interface, press "Up" or "Down" to select the required manual massage technique, and then press "OK" for confirmation; press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.





- 2). Manual Program (main menu-massage position)
- · Manual massage positions include fixed point, partial, full back, upper back, lower back and other massage functions.
- · After entering the manual program interface, press "Left" or "Right" to select the massage position function submenu. Then press "Up" or "Down" to select the desired massage position function option, and then press "OK" for confirmation; press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.


- 3). Manual Program (main menu-air pressure)
- · Manual air pressure massage includes upper body air pressure and lower body air pressure massage functions.
- · After entering the manual program interface, press "Left" or "Right" to select the air pressure massage function submenu. Press "Up" or "Down" to select the desired air massage function option, and then press "OK" to turn on or off the air massage function; Press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.

4). Manual Program (main menu-other)


- ·Other manual functions include waist heating, calf rubbing, sole roller, negative oxygen ion and so on.
- · After entering the manual program interface, press "Left" or "Right" to select other function submenus. Then press "Up" or "Down" to select other required massage function options, and then press "OK" to turn on or off the massage function selected; press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.

5). Manual Program (other-waist heating)

- · Heating function: The massage chair will become warm after 3 minutes of turning on the heating function.
- · After entering the manual program interface, press "Left" or "Right" to select other function submenus. Then press "Up" or "Down" to select the waist heating function option, and then press "OK" to turn on or off the waist heating function; press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.




6). Manual Program (others-calf rubbing)

- · Calf rubbing function can relieve the stiffness or tension of the calf muscles caused by long-time standing.
- · After entering the manual program interface, press "Left" or "Right" to select other function submenus. Press "Up" or "Down" to select the calf rubbing function option, and then press "OK" to turn on or off the calf rubbing function; press "Back" to return to the running state information interface.




7). Manual Program (other-foot roller)

- · Sole roller function includes five levels of speed adjustable.
- After entering the manual program interface, press "Left" or "Right" to select other function submenus. 

II. Voice Control Mode

At this moment, once a corresponding voice control entry to be implemented is given within six seconds, the corresponding voice control function can be performed after a reply is received from the massage chair; if no correct voice control entry is given within six seconds, the voice control function will be off automatically and needs to be enabled again.



III.Turn off the power and stop massage




The figure below depicts how to cut off the whole machine's power supply. (Schematic diagram of power switch position of the whole machine).

Schematic diagram of pulling out the power plug



Cleaning synthetic leather and plastic parts

Wipe the leather with a soft, dry cloth.

- ■Do not use chemicals such as thinner, gasoline, alcohol, etc. to clean the unit.
- ■When using commercially available leather care products (rags), please follow the instructions for use.
- ■If synthetic leather is particularly dirty, wipe it in the following way.
- ①Immerse a soft cloth in water or hot water containing 3% to 5% neutral detergent, then wring it out thoroughly.
- ②Use the above soft cloth to wipe the leather surface.
- ③Wipe off the cleaning solution with a cloth soaked in clean water and thoroughly wrung out.
- Wipe with a wrung soft cloth.
- 5Let it air dry naturally.
- ■When it is difficult to remove stains, please immerse commercially available melamine foam in neutral detergent, and then wipe the machine with it.
- ■Do not use a hair dryer to dry the surface.
- ■Be careful when wiping the machine with denim and colored fabrics, as the color of the fabric will stain the surface of the synthetic leather.
- ■Do not keep these parts in contact with plastic for a long time, as this will cause discoloration.
- ■Synthetic leather may be discolored, so when using hair dye, please cover the touched part with a towel.

Troubleshooting

Fault	When the calf mechanism and backrest are in position, the adjustment button will no longer change the position, and a "beep, beep" sound is emitted.
Solution	The product's structure and ergonomic requirements have a set adjustment limit for the protection of its design. This sound will emit when the limit is reached.

Fault	The function does not work or some functions do not work after the machine is turned on.
Solution	After the machine is turned on by pressing the switch key, it is necessary to manually select an automatic massage program or other working state. If it is not operated, the machine will automatically shut down after 20 minutes. If the manual operation mode is selected, the functions that are not selected may be disabled, and the working mode needs to be manually set in the manual mode.

Fault	The machine makes a leather rubbing sound when adjusting its posture.
Solution	This product adopts high-grade anti-corrosion leather that meets environmental protection requirements. Due to the inherent characteristics of leather materials there will be a normal slight noise when rubbing at the relative movement, which is a normal occurrence Note: If you hear fabric or leather tearing sound when the machine is running, please stop using it immediately and seek professional maintenance.

Fault	The massage wheel did not reach the shoulders or neck.
Solution	If the head does not touch the head cushion or the back does not touch the backrest, the shoulder position may be lower than the actual position during the body shape detection process. Sit in the deepest position of the seat, rest your head on the headrest, and start over from the beginning.

Fault	The unit is damaged. The power cord or power plug is abnormally hot.	
Solution	To prevent accidents, be sure to contact an authorized service center.
