<div> <div>⚠</div> <div>Caution</div> </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ If the motor sounds during operation of this product, this is the normal operation sound. ■ If the controller cannot work normally, check whether the plug and the power socket are connected reliably, and whether the power switch is turned on. ■ If the rated working time is over, this product will automatically activate the power-off button; If this product keeps operating for a long period of time, the temperature protector will stop this product automatically. The product can be used again after half an hour.

Part Installation

Calf installation instructions

1. Insert the wire of the calf and the air pipe into the front socket of the steel frame assembly (Figure 1).
2. Then push the connected wire and air pipe into the hole in the backrest frame (Figure 2).
3. After the wire docking is completed, open the calf fixing covers on both sides of the steel frame assembly (Figure 3).
4. Lift the calf into the notch, close the fixing covers, and secure it in place with 2 pieces screws (Figure 4).

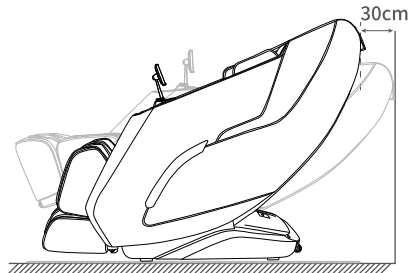


Massage Chair Placement

Installation placement

Make sure there is enough space for the massage chair to be able to tilt at least 30 cm.

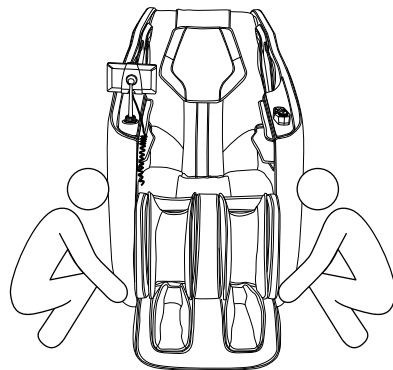
Do not expose the massage chair directly to high temperature environment due to sunlight (such as: in front of heating equipment), and place it to where can avoid high temperature and direct sunlight. It is recommended to lay a soft, protective mat underneath the chair for long-term use in a designated location. When laying the mat, the size of the mat should be enough to cover the complete underside of the chair. Keep the range where the machine touches the floor and the range where your feet touch the floor.



Product lift instruction

A team lift is required to move the chair and avoid injury.

1. Please lift the massage chair to move it on vulnerable ground such as wooden floor.
2. To avoid damage to any similar type of floor as well as the chair's casters, it is recommended the chair be lifted when moved and not slid or pushed. When the chair is lifted and moved to the designated position, be careful to keep your hands and feet out of the way to avoid injury. Do not let go of the unit until the unit is completely flat and level on the ground. To prevent damage to the floor, it is recommended to place a mat or protective barrier between the unit and the floor.



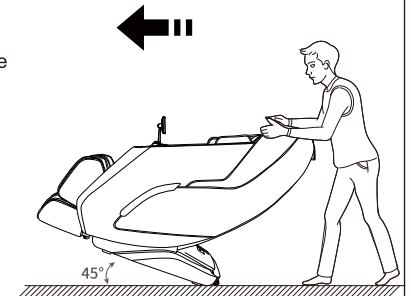
Massage Chair Placement

Move method

Use the rear casters to move the massage chair. Move the chair by tilting it down and backward about 45° as shown in the diagram.

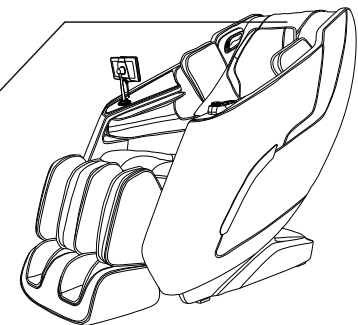
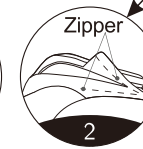
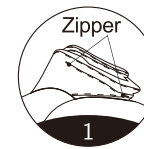
NOTE: Excessive force to tilt will cause the chair to tip over completely and product damage.

1. Before moving, please shut down the machine properly to reset the whole machine, and then cut off the power.
2. Please keep the chair vacant when moving. (People, pets or clutter will not be able to stay on the chair.)
3. When moving, do not cross a drop barrier higher than 2mm or a gap greater than 5mm.
4. When using casters to move this product, single continuous movement is not supported; if the distance exceeds 50 meters, please make this product move slowly and evenly.



How to disassemble and use headrest cushion and backrest cushion

Using a headrest cushion can reduce the intensity of kneading massage on the neck and shoulders, and you can decide whether to use a headrest cushion according to your needs (recommended to use a headrest cushion). The backrest cushion and the backrest are connected by a zipper (1), and the headrest cushion and the backrest cushion are connected by a zipper (2).

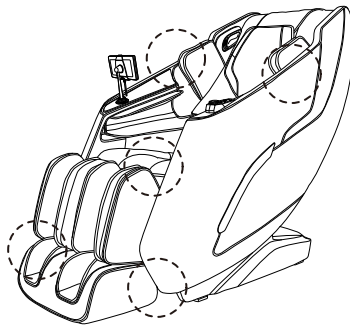
Check around

Make sure that there are no people, pets and other objects around the unit.



Make sure there are no foreign objects in the gaps of the machine

Before massaging, make sure that no foreign objects are caught in the legs, feet, etc.
Under no circumstances allow hands, feet, and head to penetrate into the area between the lower leg mechanism and main body, or the area between the armrest and the capsule.
Under no circumstances should hands, feet, or head sink under the fabric or leather covering of the massage area.

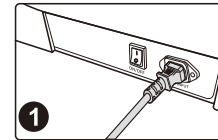

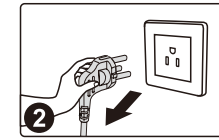

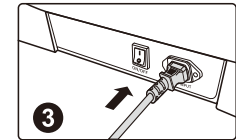

Schematic diagram of power on



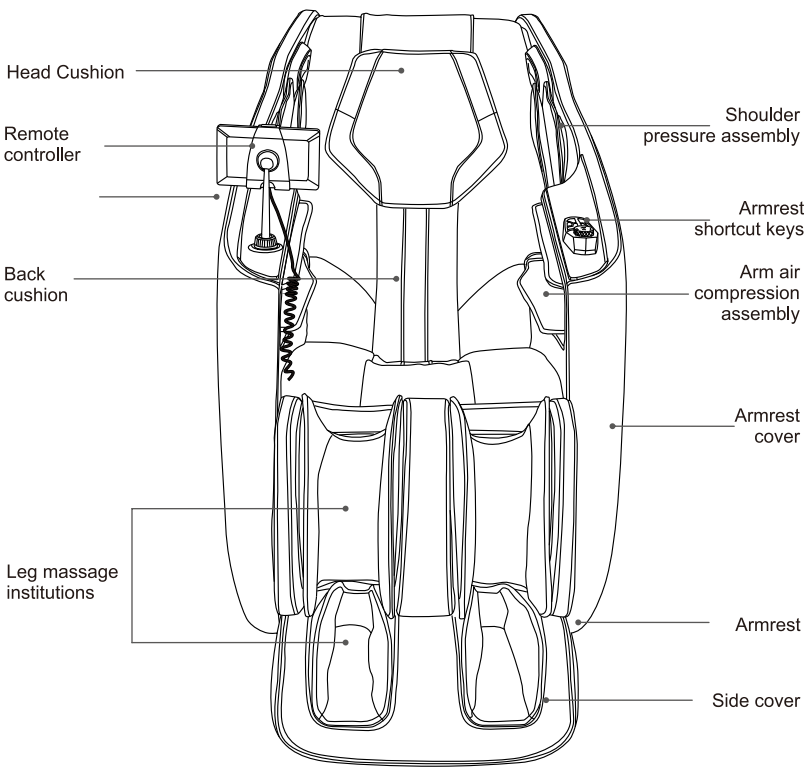
Turn on the power switch ("I" position)

- It is strictly forbidden to connect various power conversion devices to supply power to this product without authorization.

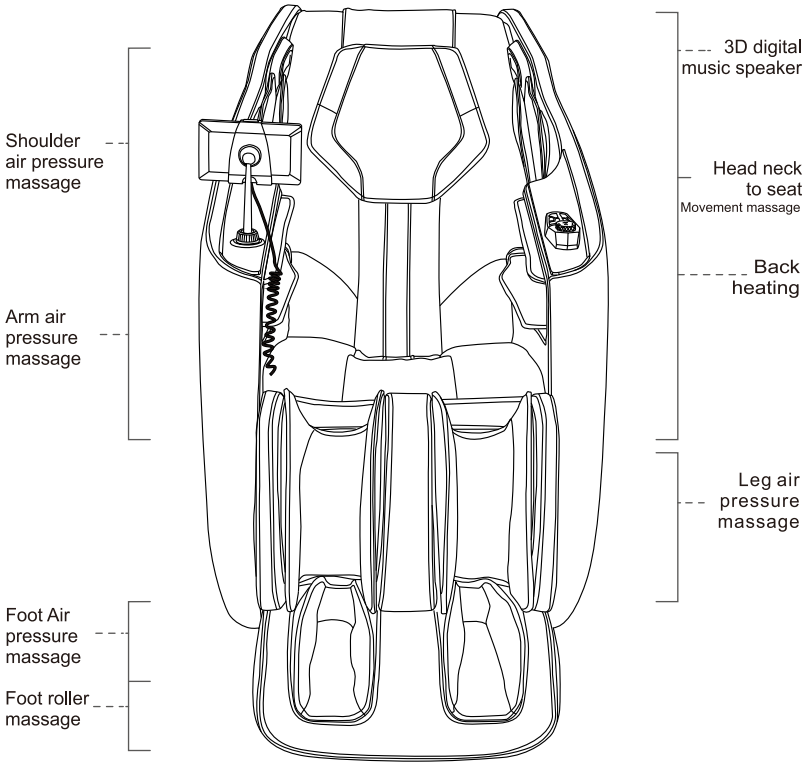

Parts description



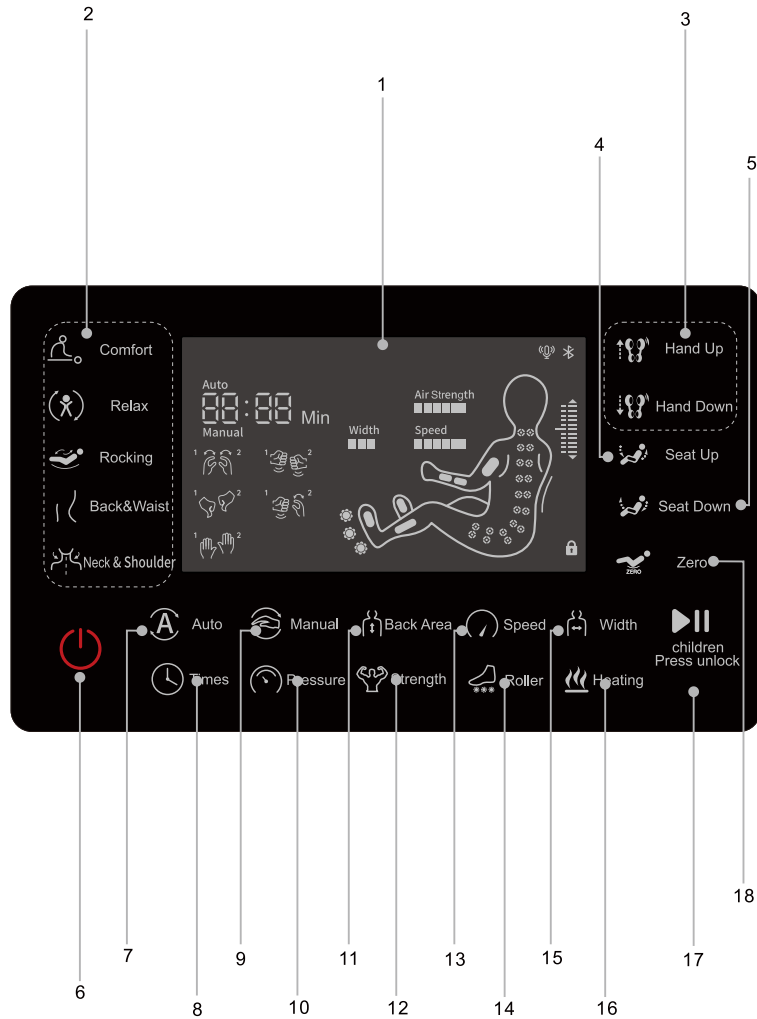

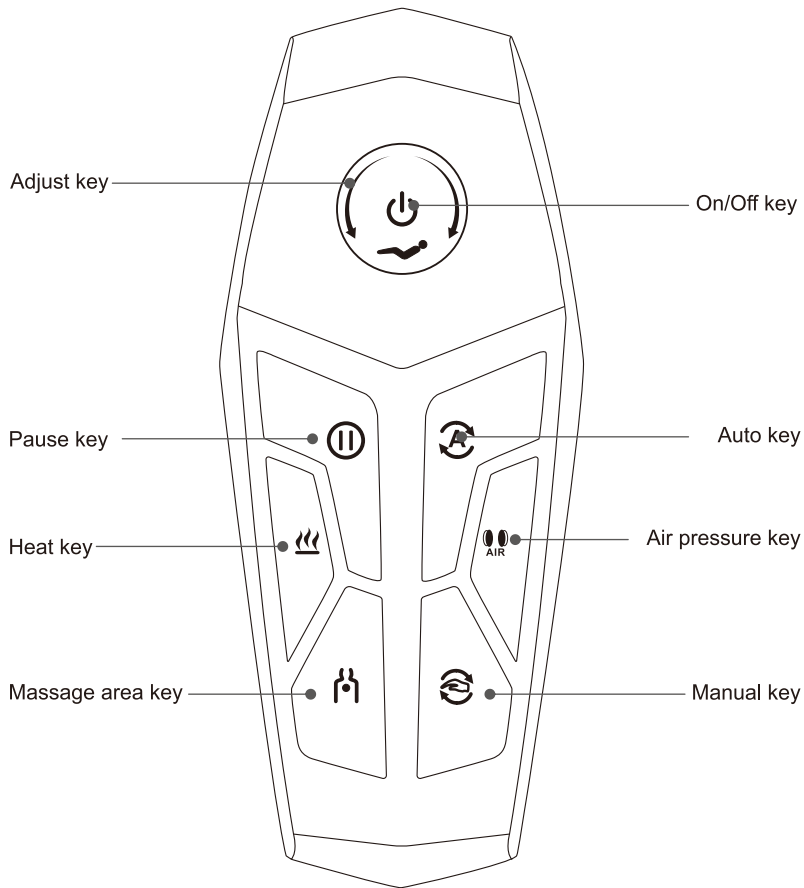

- 1.LCD screen
 - Display all massage functions.
- 2.Auto Key
 - For details,please refer to page 17 of this manual.
- 3.Massage hand adjust key
 - Adjust the position of shiatsu points on shoulder,massage positions adjustment (in fixed point mode and partial mode , the massage position can be adjusted).
- 4.Sitting posture up button
 - Adjust the sitting posture to rise.
- 5.Sitting posture down button
 - Adjust the sitting posture to descend.
- 6.Power switch key
 - Turn on or off all massage chair functions.
- 7.Auto Program key
 - There are 7 kinds of massage procedures,please refer to page 17 of this manual for details.
- 8.Times Key
 - Time adjustment please refer to page 20 of this manual for detail instructions.
- 9.Manual key
 - For details,please refer to page 18 of this manual .
- 10.Air pressure area key
 - Adjust the massage area,for detailed instructions,please refer to page 19 of this manual.
- 11.Massage area key
 - Adjust the massage area,for detailed instructions,please refer to page 18 of this manual.
- 12.Air pressure intensity key
 - A total of five levels of air pressure can be adjusted.
- 13.Speed key
 - There are 5 levels of massage speed that can be adjusted.
- 14.Foot roller key
 - For details,please refer to page 19 of this manual.
- 15.Width key
 - A total of three levels of width can be adjusted.
- 16.Back heating key
 - Turn on/ Off heating.
- 17.Pause/start key
 - For details,please refer to page 19 of this manual.
- 18.Auto lying key
 - There are four automatic lying modes and reset and standing modes(including the reset and standing mode), which can be switched cyclically according to your own needs.

II. Introduction to Armrest Shortcut Keys

Function	Description
	Power key: Short press this key to turn ON/OFF the massage.
	Linkage lying knob: By rotating this knob clockwise, the backrest will move downward slowly and the legrest will rise slowly; by releasing it, such DOWN/UP action of the backrest and the legrest will be stopped.
	Linkage sitting knob: By rotating this knob counterclockwise, the backrest will rise slowly and the legrest will move downward slowly; by releasing it, such UP/DOWN action of the backrest and the legrest will be stopped.
	Press this key during massage, and all the massage actions will be suspended at once. (i.e. the massage chair will turn off after 20min). Then press this key again to restore all the previous massage actions.
	Auto mode key: each time the key is short pressed, it will be switched to next automatic massage function.
	Heat treatment key: Click the key to enable or disable the heat treatment function.
	Air pressure key: Each time the button is pressed, it switches to an air pressure mode, with a total of four modes (including turning off air pressure), which can be switched cyclically.
	Massage area key: press this button to switch the back stretch mode
	Manual key: each time the key is short pressed, it will be switched to next technique massage function.

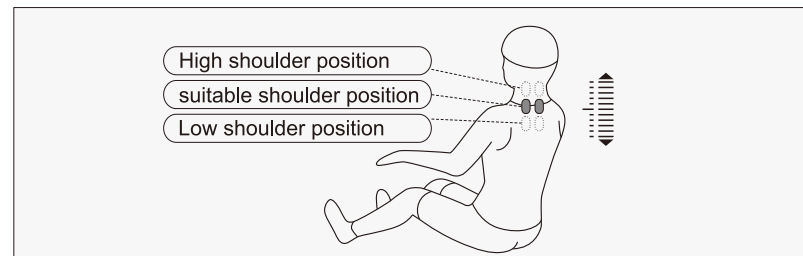

III. Start massage

- ①. Press the power button to start the massage, the default is comfort massage.
- ②. Automatic angle adjustment (you can press the "A Auto"/"A" button to skip).
- ③. Automatic human shoulder position detection, keep the sitting posture fit with the massage chair (you can press the "A Auto"/"A" button to skip).
- ④. Shoulder position fine-tuning, if the detected position deviates from the actual shoulder position, adjust it to the appropriate position through the up and down buttons of the shoulder position (you can press the "A Auto"/"A" button to skip), there are 11 shoulder positions in total. If there is no adjustment within 10 seconds, it will enter into the massage function.

Note: You can select the automatic function during the booting process. Repeatedly selecting the same automatic function can skip the booting process and enter the massage directly.








V-chip		Press and hold pause/start key for 3 seconds to enable child lock, display shows  that lock is successful, and other keys cannot be used after being locked; Press and hold pause/start key for 3 seconds in locked state to disable child lock, and the display disappears  , indicating that unlock is successful and keys function returns to normal.

· Adjust lying Angle

Function	Button	Description
Sit up	 Seat Up	Press this button, the backrest frame will slowly rise, calf frame will slowly fall, and will release a sound until it reaches the top. Press this button again in the process of sitting, then the chair will stop in its selected position.
Lay down key	 Seat Down	Press this key, the backrest frame will slowly lower down, calf frame will slowly rise up, and will release a sound until it reaches the top. Press this key again in lying down process, then the chair will stop in its selected position.
Lie down automatically	 Zero	Each time the button is pressed, it switches to an automatic lying mode, with a total of four modes (including the reset and standing mode), which can be switched cyclically.

· Other manual functions

IV. Operation Instructions for Bluetooth Speaker Play

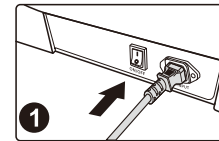
1. Enter the smart device main menu, Open "Settings" and select the "Bluetooth" options. Open "Bluetooth", and Bluetooth will automatically "Search for a New Bluetooth Device".
2. The smart device will search for the corresponding Bluetooth model (e.g. IMCM-XXXX), Click the "Match" button, if you are asked whether to match with the device, you just select "Match" to complete matching.
3. Turn on "Music Player" in the smart device and select the song to play.

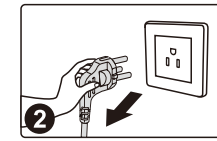
VI. End the massage

1. During the massage process, press the power key of touch screen controller to immediately turn off all massage functions, the backrest and leg rest will reset, or when the massage timer expires, it will automatically turn off all massage functions, but the backrest and leg rest will not reset.

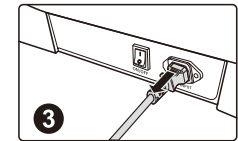
Cut off the power of the whole machine. Figure (switch power off)

Take off the power plug



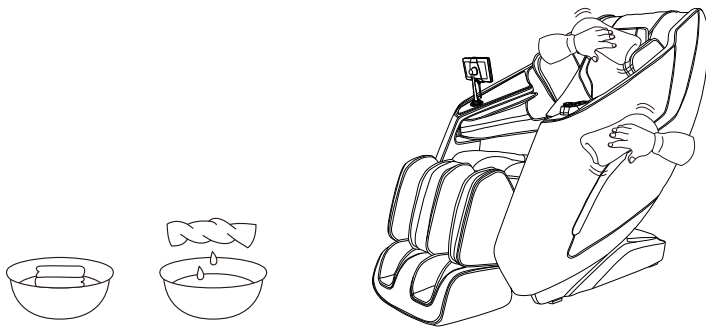
Take off the product power cable.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Clean PVC leather and plastic parts

Wipe the leather with a soft, dry cloth.

- Do not use chemicals such as thinner, gasoline, alcohol, etc. to clean the unit.
- When using commercially available leather care products (rags), please follow the instructions for use.
- If the PVC leather is particularly dirty, wipe it by the following methods.
 - ① Immerse a soft cloth in water or hot water containing 3% to 5% neutral detergent, then wring it out thoroughly.
 - ② Use the above soft cloth to wipe the leather surface.
 - ③ Wipe off the cleaning solution with a cloth soaked in clean water and thoroughly wrung out.
 - ④ Wipe with a wrung soft cloth.
 - ⑤ Let it air dry naturally.
- When it is difficult to remove stains, please immerse commercially available melamine foam in neutral detergent, and then wipe the machine with it.
- Do not use a hair dryer to dry the surface.
- As the color of the fabric will stain the surface of the PVC leather, be careful when wiping the chair with denim and colored fabrics.
- Do not keep these parts in contact with plastic for a long time, as this will cause discoloration.
- PVC leather may be discolored, so when using hair dye, please cover the touched part with a towel.



Troubleshooting

Fault	When the calf mechanism and backrest are in position, the adjustment button will no longer change the position, and a "beep, beep" sound is emitted.
Solution	The product's structure and ergonomic requirements have a set adjustment limit for the protection of its design. This sound will emit when the limit is reached.
Fault	The function does not work or some functions do not work after the machine is turned on.
Solution	After the machine is turned on by pressing the switch key, it is necessary to manually select an automatic massage program or other working state. If it is not operated, the machine will automatically shut down after 20 minutes. If the manual operation mode is selected, the functions that are not selected may be disabled, and the working mode needs to be manually set in the manual mode.
Fault	The machine makes a leather rubbing sound when adjusting its posture.
Solution	This product adopts high-grade anti-corrosion leather that meets environmental protection requirements. Due to the inherent characteristics of leather materials, there will be a normal slight noise when rubbing at the relative movement, which is a normal occurrence. Note: If you hear fabric or leather tearing sound when the machine is running, please stop using it immediately and seek professional maintenance.
Fault	The massage wheel does not reach the shoulders or neck.
Solution	If the head does not touch the head cushion or the back does not touch the backrest, the shoulder position may be lower than the actual position during the body shape detection process. Sit in the deepest position of the seat, rest your head on the headrest, and start over from the beginning.
Fault	The unit is damaged. The power cord or power plug is abnormally hot.
Solution	To prevent accidents, be sure to contact an authorized service center.
